

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) - Answer Key

1. PPE is generally considered:
A - A last line of defense after higher-level controls are considered
2. Employees required to use PPE should know:
A - When and what PPE is needed, how to use it, limitations, care and disposal
3. Damaged PPE should be:
A - Removed from use and replaced/repaired as appropriate
4. Proper fit matters because:
A - Poor fit can reduce protection
5. A face shield:
A - May supplement but does not always replace required eye protection
6. PPE selection should be based on:
A - A workplace hazard assessment and task exposure
7. Employees should demonstrate:
A - Understanding and ability to use PPE properly
8. Retraining may be needed when:
A - Workplace/PPE changes or an employee lacks required understanding/skill
9. PPE compatibility means:
A - Multiple PPE items can be worn together without defeating protection
10. This general course replaces the employer PPE hazard assessment.
