29 CFR 1910.178(l)

1. OSHA PIT training must include:
A - Formal instruction, practical training and workplace evaluation
2. Operator performance must be evaluated at least:
A - Once every three years
3. A forklift load should generally be carried:
A - Low and stable while traveling
4. If a load blocks forward view, the operator should:
A - Use a safe travel method such as reverse travel when appropriate and allowed
5. Pedestrians should:
A - Be kept clear of the truck/load path and never stand under raised forks
6. A truck with a safety defect should be:
A - Removed from service until corrected
7. Refresher training can be triggered by:
A - Unsafe operation, accident/near miss, unsafe evaluation, different truck or workplace change
8. The capacity plate matters because it:
A - Shows rated capacity and conditions/attachments that affect capacity
9. At a blind intersection the operator should:
A - Slow and use the horn/other site controls
10. Passing this course by itself means the employee is OSHA-certified to operate a forklift.
