

Front-End Loader Safety Fundamentals - Answer Key

1. A raised loader bucket generally:
A - Raises the center of gravity and can reduce stability
2. A loader operator should normally travel with the bucket:
A - Low as practical for stability/visibility
3. Blind spots are best controlled with:
A - Site controls, operator checks and spotters/cameras as appropriate
4. Before operating, inspect:
A - Machine and work area
5. On slopes the operator should:
A - Follow manufacturer/site limits and procedures
6. People should be:
A - Kept clear of bucket/load and machine travel zones
7. Maintenance under a raised attachment requires:
A - Approved blocking/support and energy control as applicable
8. ROPS and operator restraint:
A - Work together to protect the operator in a rollover when used as designed
9. A spotter should use:
A - Agreed signals and remain visible/safely positioned
10. This course alone qualifies an operator on every loader model.
